

FIGURE SKATING AUDITION

The mission of the Figure Skating Department is help to develop each skater to the maximum of his/her skating ability, with heavy emphasis on the Performance aspect of skating. We encourage strong academic students who are passionate about figure skating to apply. We are available to assist you in this process.

The Figure Skating program will focus on individualized training schedules depending on each skater's level of ability. It will also instill a strong emphasis on strength, flexibility, training; and especially on Performance and Expression. The program will also provide an examination and understanding of the United States Figure Skating Association rules.

Performance Auditions will be held at the Steel Ice Center as arranged with the Director of Figure Skating. All Performance Auditions will be done in the context of the candidate's chosen music and figure skating routine, and should exhibit a variety of elements including a variety of jumps and spins, skating footwork and choreography. Candidates may also be required to demonstrate isolated figure skating elements.

Following your Performance Audition, you and your parent will be interviewed by the auditioning committee. We would like to know why you wish to attend the Lehigh Valley Charter High School for the Performing Arts, and what your goals are as a figure skater. Candidates should be prepared to express their beliefs and ambitions.
