

Visual Art Department Audition Requirements

Parent/guardians should assist their child with putting together a folder containing important audition materials.

Pre-audition:

- Parents/guardians are encouraged to set up a shadowing appointment through the main office.
- Student should create/refine artworks that best represent current skill level and creativity (Check artwork requirements list).
- Prepare the Art Audition Folder
- Student should rest and try to relax before the audition day

Manilla Audition Folder Contents:

1. Recent photograph of applicant
2. Photographs or disc containing photographs of artwork
3. 3-5 paragraph essay on an influential or favorite artist.

Artwork Requirements (minimum of 5 artworks):

1. Self Portrait from observation (in front of mirror)
2. Still Life from observation (in front of still life arrangement)
3. Landscape or Cityscape (from observation or photograph)
4. Artwork of choice demonstrating skill and creativity
5. Artwork of choice demonstrating skill and creativity

Note: photograph all artworks and place them in manilla folder.

Audition Day:

1. Be ready to answer questions asked of you by the art faculty.
2. Be ready to talk about yourself as a student and developing artist.
3. Present completed folder to the art faculty.
4. Present original artworks to art faculty (student will take originals home).
